Sonshine Kids Kindergarten class offers a program for kids with a low student/teacher ratio of 12:2. We utilize Starfall Reading and Language Arts curriculum that is motivational and engaging while integrating Phonemic Awareness, Phonics, Vocabulary, Fluency, Comprehension and Writing. This class incorporates journal writing and guided reading with hands-on math and science, while still getting to enjoy the FUN of a preschool setting! This class will participate in weekly school-wide chapel services, Music class, P.E. class and computer lab.

Research

National Institute for Early Education Research (NIEER) reports that smaller class sizes allow teachers to interact more effectively with the children and provide more individualized instruction. In a small class, the teacher gets to know students better and responds more quickly and appropriately to tailor instruction to children who need help. The teacher spends more time talking to and teaching students and less time managing the class.

The National Day Care Study randomly assigned preschool students to a class size. The study concluded that children in small preschool classes ended the year with more knowledge, larger vocabularies and more cooperative behaviors, and they experienced fewer conflicts with classmates than children in larger classes. According to the Great Schools staff, the gains continued as the students got older; students assigned to smaller classes are held back less often, achieve higher grades, and are more likely to graduate.
